

Preparatory work will take place midweek nights with the main beam installation work taking place during weekend closures of the railway as follows:

Start	Finish	Work to be carried out
06:00 Thursday 18 Jun 2026	06:00 Wednesday 1 Jul 2026	The station will remain open to passengers, but parking at Coulsdon South station car park will be reduced, with some bays suspended to allow us to set up a small compound for materials and machinery storage. From 18 June 2026 to 1 July 2026 between 21:30 and 05:30 we will be undertaking welding works to the support frames either side of the road under the bridge. There will be alternate lane closures with traffic lights in place on Brighton Road from 21:30 Thursday 18 June 2026 to 06:00 Wednesday 1 July 2026. There will be pedestrian access under the bridge during this time.
20:00 Wednesday 22 Jul 2026	00:30 Wednesday 29 Jul 2026	The station will be open to passengers but there will be no parking at Coulsdon South station as the car park will be closed and the parking bays suspended to allow us to prepare for the works and set up a crane to lift the protection beams into place. There will be a drop off and pick up area as normal at the station via the one-way route in front of the station. Taxi bays will be relocated to the south of the station car park. There will be lane closures with traffic lights in place on Brighton Road from 19:00 Friday 24 July 2026 to 22:00 Saturday the 25 July 2026 There will be pedestrian access under the bridge during this time. The lane closure will then change to a full road closure from 22:00 Saturday the 25 July 2026 (please see the work under the main works heading below)
22:00 Saturday 25 Jul 2026	06:00 Monday 27 Jul 2026	<u>MAIN WORKS</u> Installing the protection beams using a crane from the road and car park area. There will be a full road closure with a signed diversion route in place on Brighton Road (A23) from 22:00 Saturday 25 July to 06:00 Monday the 27 July 2026. The bus stops will be suspended, and the buses will be on a diversion route during this time. This is to make sure the public is safe while we carry out lifting operations. There will be a drop off and pick up point with a turnaround space near the bus stop on Brighton Road for passengers. Please note this will strictly be a drop-off/pick up zone only to allow everyone access as there is no space to park your vehicles. Pedestrians will not be able to go under the bridge and there will be a signed diversion route via the steps to alternative routes. However, anyone who has mobility concerns and is unable to use the steps will be escorted by marshals through the work site when it is safe to do so. You may be delayed while we wait for any lifting operations to be completed and the work site made safe.
21:30 Monday 27 Jul 2026	05:30 Friday 31 Jul 2026	Each night (Monday to Thursday) between 21:30 and 05:30 there will be a lane closure in place on Brighton Road to complete the final works to the bridge which will include painting, signage and installing the chevrons on the bridge. There will be pedestrian access under the bridge during this time. Bus stops on Brighton Road will be open as usual during this period and there will be reduced parking at the station.
21:30 Monday 17 Aug 2026	05:30 Friday 21 Aug 2026	As a contingency, if needed, each night (Monday to Thursday) between 21:30 and 05:30 there will be a full road closure in place on Brighton Road (A23) to complete any final finishing works on the bridge. The station car park will have reduced parking capacity and the pick-up/drop off in front of the station will be maintained throughout. Pedestrians will not be able to go under the bridge and there will be a signed diversion route via the steps to alternative routes. However, anyone who has mobility concerns and is unable to use the steps will be escorted by marshals through the work site when it is safe to do so. You may be delayed while we wait for any lifting operations to be completed and the work site made safe.
